At London, 30 November 1812 before the reverend Doctor James Watt Doctor of Divinity and Surgeon Extraordinary Physician to the Queen (late of the Royal Hospital Chelsea) Justice of the Peace for the County of Middlesex and one of the Executors to whom administration was granted carrying his full powers only to administer power reserved of making a grant to William Pearce the other Executor to whom the seal append for the same.

On the 30th November 1812 Administration (with the will annexed) of the goods chattels and effects of Sarah Pearce late of Barbadoes Buildings etc Cross Street in the City of London spinneresse was granted to Elizabeth Russell widow the natural and lawful Doctor and one of the next of kin of the said deceased carrying his full powers only to administer the Executor or Administratrix designated.
