### Introduction.

So little is known of the laws which governed this country before the Saxon domination that all serious study of English Law must commence at that period. The temporal and spiritual jurisdictions appear to have been distinct, although the judges representing the two sections sat together in the county or in the hundred court. The matters presided over by the heads of the Church were those concerning which the clergy, by virtue of their office, might be expected to exercise a more fitting control than their secular brothers, and included tithes, as such were paid to churchmen; matrimony, as these contracts were generally made with the blessing of the church; and testaments, as a will was frequently executed when the testator was at the point of death, and in the presence of his spiritual guide.

On the accession of the first Norman king to the throne of England the distinction was made much more marked. The success of William was due in a great measure to papal approval, and, in return, he was naturally willing to advance the contention of the court of Rome that all ecclesiastical persons and causes should be only subject to the jurisdiction of the spiritual courts. In accordance with this policy separate tribunals were established for ecclesiastical matters and these were presided over by dignitaries of the Church. The matters over which these

judges had authority consisted of blasphemy, apostacy from Christianity, heresy and schism, admissions and institutions of clerks, celebration of divine service, rights of matrimony, tithes, oblations and obventions, reparation of churches, probate of testaments and the administration of the estates of deceased persons, simony, penances, and offences against morality generally.

The curiæ christianæ were of many descriptions, and included that known as the "peculiar." This was a jurisdiction exempt from the authority of the ordinary of the diocese in which it was situated, and subject to its own ordinary. At one time there were nearly three hundred of these courts, and they "were, for the most part, introduced by the Pope into this country, and seem to have had for their principal object the curtailment of the bishop's legitimate authority in his diocese . . . . . , an object which they certainly attained, to the great confusion of ecclesiastical jurisdiction for many years." As an instance of how unsuited these and other minor courts were for the exercise of the power vested in them, it is recorded in Canon 126, of 1603, that "deans, archdeacons, prebendaries, parsons, vicars, and others exercising ecclesiastical jurisdiction, claim liberty to prove the last wills and testaments of persons deceased within their several jurisdictions, having no known or certain registrars, nor public places to keep their records in."1

The following were the different peculiar courts in existence.

1. Royal Peculiars: the king's free chapels which were exempt from all jurisdiction save that of their ordinary, the sovereign.

- 2. Archbishops' Peculiars: exclusive of the bishops and archdeacons, and originating in a privilege of jurisdiction over the site of their seats and possessions.
- 3. Bishops' Peculiars: (a) jurisdictions which a bishop enjoyed in the diocese of another, e.g., over a house he possessed in another diocese; and (b) jurisdictions which a bishop possessed in his own diocese, exclusive of that exercised by the archdeacon, as over churches regular of monks, canons and other religious houses.<sup>2</sup>
- 4. Peculiars of deans, deans and chapters, prebendaries, rectors, etc.: places wherein by ancient compositions the bishops had parted with their jurisdictions as ordinaries to the bodies, etc., mentioned.
- 5. Peculiars belonging to monasteries which, before the Dissolution, were exempt from the visitation and jurisdiction of the ordinary, but were afterwards subject to that of the ordinary within whose diocese they were situated.

The parish of Hawarden was the peculiar of a rector exempt from the control of any bishop. This exemption appears to have been primarily due to the fact that the living had been in the gift of a religious house and, as such, not subject to the visitations of a bishop. Moreover, it is to be remembered that the diocese of Chester was only carved out of the diocese of Lichfield in 1541, and that the parish of Hawarden was part of a long unsettled district, sometimes under the control of the princes of Wales, and at other times under that of the sovereigns of the adjoining country. No doubt the difficulty of the Bishop of Lichfield on the one hand, and of the Bishop of St. Asaph on the other, in proving his title to the jurisdiction of the border parish, was the chief bulwark of the rector's independence.

Until the middle of the thirteenth century the Rectory of Hawarden was in the possession of the Abbey of St. Werburgh in Chester, but, about that time, the then Cheshire Palatinate Baron of Montalt restored to the Abbey certain lands in exchange for the manor of Brocton, the chapel and tenement of Sponne, and the living of Hawarden. The great tithes of that place were surrendered at the same time to the rector of Hawarden for ever, and the grant was subsequently ratified by the Popes Honorius and Clement.

The last Baron of Montalt settled his lands upon Isabella, wife of Edward II., who transferred the Castle and Manor of Hawarden to William de Montacute, Earl of Salisbury, in exchange for other property. In 1406 the Montacutes forfeited their possession on account of treason, and Henry V. granted the advowson of Hawarden. together with the lordship and Castle, to Thomas, Duke of Clarence, who was slain in battle in 1420. Hawarden subsequently passed to the Stanleys, the Nevilles, and then again to the Stanleys, Earls of Derby, with which family it remained until the time of the Civil War, when Sergeant Glynne purchased the inheritance of Hawarden Castle and Rectory. On the Glynne family becoming extinct in the male line on the death of the late Sir Stephen R. Glynne, Bart., the property passed under his will to his nephew, the late Mr. Wm. H. Gladstone, and on the death of the latter to his son, Mr. William Glynne Charles Gladstone, M.P., the present owner, and Lord Lieutenant of Flintshire.

From the time of separation from the Abbey of St. Werburgh the ecclesiastical jurisdiction was vested in the

Rector alone. He held his own court, in which local wills were proved, letters of administration and marriage licenses granted, and lapses from orthodoxy, morality, and other offences against ecclesiastical law were punished by penance, fine, and even imprisonment in the gaol of the sheriff at Flint.

The special spiritual functions of a Bishop—institution, confirmation, and consecration of churches—could not of course be performed by any dignitary of the Church of lower ecclesiastical rank, and, in the case of non-episcopal peculiars, for such purposes it was usually the custom to invoke the assistance of the bishop within the ambit of whose diocese the peculiar was situated, or the bishop of the nearest cathedral town.

The rectors of Hawarden, however, do not appear to have followed any rule in the matter. It is said they were in the habit of calling in Irish bishops passing through the neighbourhood, and, for many years, the bishops of Chester were called upon to confirm, and the bishops of St. Asaph to institute. The Peculiar of Hawarden appears to have been a continual thorn in the side of the bishops of Chester, who claimed to exercise a "strictly episcopal" jurisdiction over the parish, which the rectors of Hawarden strenuously opposed, and which the bishops do not appear to have had the power to enforce. Appeals from the consistorial court of Hawarden were made to the Archbishop of York, who was Visitor, and in whose possession was a copy of the terrier of its tithes.

The holding of the court was announced on the preceding Sunday by a citation, read aloud in the Church at the conclusion of morning prayer, in which the rector, through the registrar, called upon the "clergy and literate persons" in the peculiar to summon certain persons, whose

names were given, to appear "before us our lawful Surrogate or some other judge competent in this case in the Parish Church of Hawarden and place of judicature," on the date, and at the time appointed, to answer "interrogations concerning their soul's health and the reformation of their manners especially concerning crimes and misdemeanors as mentioned opposite their names."

The churchwardens and sidesmen were also called upon to appear and exhibit their presentments and bills of "detection of all crimes cognizable before us and our Bench Ecclesiastical within the peculiarity aforesaid done or committed and hitherto unpunished," and to exhibit register rolls of all births, marriages, and burials within the limits of the peculiar.

Executors were summoned to prove wills, and "children and next of kin or any having or pretending to have any interest in the goods, chattels, and credits" of one who had died intestate, so that letters of administration might be granted. Others were summoned to answer in "certain cases of fornication or incontinence and illegal cohabitation and all . . . . . who have neglected or refused to pay their several and respective Church leys and Church taxes."

The event took place, with all the ceremony of a court-of-law, upon the Tuesday preceding Holy Thursday, in a room at the east end of the present Whitley Chapel in Hawarden Church, and was presided over by the rector, who was attended by his curates, surrogates, proctors, registrar, and apparitor, all in their robes. Those matters which had connection with the estate of deceased persons were first dealt with, the presentments of the churchwardens were next examined, and the trial of those who had been presented followed. In the parish of Hawarden there were fifteen townships, and for each of these there were two

representative sidesmen who were sworn informers and had, among other things, the right to search houses in pursuit of their office.

The presentments are well worthy of a special study, as, in addition to their generally interesting character, they are a means by which much light is thrown upon the customs of those days, and upon obscure periods in the lives of all ranks.<sup>5</sup>

For contumacy in declining to appear when summoned to the court the penalty was excommunication, the equivalent in ecclesiastical courts of outlawry in the Civil Court; and as the sentence of excommunication deprived the culprit "not only of the sacraments of the Church, and the benefit of divine offices, but also of the society and conversation of the faithful," it was not to be lightly incurred.

The system of inflicting penances ceased about 1820, and the next thirty years witnessed the gradual curtailment of the powers of the peculiars, and their final abolition. The Ecclesiastical Commissioners were empowered by statutes of 6 and 7 W.IV., and 13 and 14 Vic., to frame schemes for their abolition, and by an Act of 1 and 2 Vic. certain jurisdiction over all peculiars within their province or diocese was granted to the archbishops and bishops. Two years later it was ordered that all proceedings against clerks in holy orders should take place before the bishop of the diocese, and, by an annual Act of 10 and 11 Vic., continued yearly, it was decreed that the bishop of every diocese should exercise jurisdiction throughout his diocese, but by a section of the Act the power to grant marriage

licences was continued to the authority of a peculiar, and this remnant of power is still vested in the rector of Hawarden.

The ancient seal of the Peculiar of Hawarden, on which was a representation of the Virgin, was destroyed during the Civil War, and the one now in use for sealing marriage licences bears the arms of the Rev. Lawrence Fogg, who was Rector from 1653 to 1662. It is of silver, and represents Daniel in the lions' den with this inscription round the edge; "Sigillum: peculiaris: et exemptæ: jurisdictionis: de Hawarden."

On the abolition of the court, the wills, administrations, inventories, act books, a number of citations, and a few marriage licences and miscellaneous papers were transferred to the District Probate Registry at St. Asaph. They were packed in brown paper parcels, and appear to have remained practically untouched until a few years ago, when a cursory examination was made, and it was realised that the valuable amount of information which they contained was to all intents and purposes inaccessible owing to lack of arrangement.

The matter was borne in mind, and when an opportunity offered the records were re-examined one by one, placed in separate covers where advisable, sorted into bundles for each letter of the alphabet, and indexed. For various reasons it was not always found practicable to restore an inventory, etc., to the cover containing the will relating to the same person, and in such instances the paper was filed in a separate cover. It should also be noted that the date shewn in the index is not always that on which probate was granted, as frequently that date is not given on the will, and the year shewn is the one in which the will was made.

These four volumes contain no indexes, and probate and ordinary parish matters are not separated.

This volume contains a loose index to the wills, etc., proved for the period.

There is an index in this volume to the wills proved and administrations granted, and it contains in addition particulars of various parish matters.
